

ed to him, with the help of the Holy Spirit.



## SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. GERTRUDE, VIRGIN
NOV 16<sup>th</sup>



**St. Gertrude the Great**, or St. Gertrude of Helfta, was born on Jan 6, 1256, in Germany. Pope Benedict XIV gave her the title, "**the Great**," making her the only woman saint to be called, "the Great."

**St. Gertrude the Great** was placed in the care of the Benedictine nuns at Rodalsdorf when she was five years old. She **became a nun** in the same monastery, of which she was **elected Abbess**. The following year she was obliged to take charge of the monastery at Helfta, to which she moved with her nuns.

St. Gertrude the Great was always in a deep relationship with the Lord in prayer that led to her being hailed as a mystic. She was also regarded as a great theologian. Her book, Spiritual Exercises, a compilation of prayers, meditations, and spiritual practices, helps the reader grow in devotion, virtue, a love for the Eucharist, and devotion to the Sacred Heart.

**St. Gertrude the Great** was **exceptionally devout** and saw to it that the sisters regularly contemplated the boundless love of Christ. The daily life at the monastery consisted of singing, praying the Divine Office, studying Scripture and the Church Fathers.

St. Gertrude the Great died in 1302. Patron saint of nuns and West Indies. She is often invoked for souls in purgatory.

### Saying of the saint

"Every time we **look at the Blessed**St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.

"Angels constantly guard the clients of this Blessed Virgin from the assaults of Hell." - St. Gertrude the Great.


