


FR. PAUL'S COLUMN SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. JOHN OF CAPISTRANO, PRIEST

OCT 23rd



Kingdom of Naple. He was made **governor of Perugia at the age of 26**. He was **imprisoned** after a battle against the Malatestas. Being confined to the four walls of a prison made him realize how precious was the life that God had given him, and he **decided to change his way of life completely**. At the age of 30 he **entered the Franciscan** novitiate and was **ordained a priest in 1421**.



St. John of Capistrano fasted, went barefoot, and slept little throughout his life. In a **shocking display of humility** after giving his life to Christ, John mounted a donkey backwards and rode through the streets of his town **wearing only a list of his worst sins**. People ridiculed him and pelted him with mud and dung.
