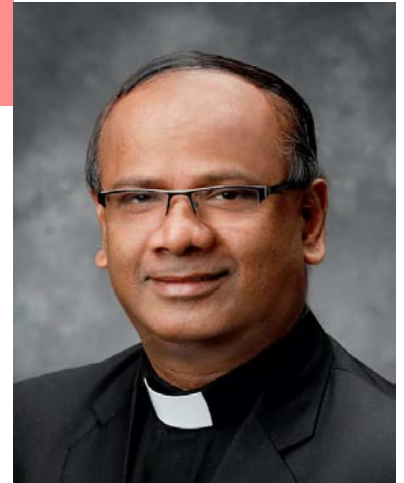

# FR. PAUL'S COLUMN

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### ST. JUAN DIEGO CUAUHTLATOATZIN

DEC 9<sup>TH</sup>



**St. Juan Diego** was born in 1474 as Cuauhtlatoatzin, a native to Mexico. He became the **first Roman Catholic indigenous saint from the Americas**. When he was 50 years old, he was **baptized by a Franciscan priest**, Fr Peter da Gand, one of the first Franciscan missionaries.

On 9 December 1531, when **St. Juan Diego** was on his way to morning Mass, **the Blessed Mother appeared to him on Tepeyac Hill**, the outskirts of what is now Mexico City. Mary told Juan Diego she was the mother of all those who lived in his land and asked him to make a request to the local bishop. **She wanted them to build a chapel in her honor there on Tepeyac Hill**, which was the site of a former pagan temple.

**The Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe**, located at the foot of Tepeyac, houses the cloak (tilmahtli) that is **traditionally said to be Juan Diego's**, and upon which **the image of the Virgin is said to have been miraculously impressed** as proof of the authenticity of the apparitions.

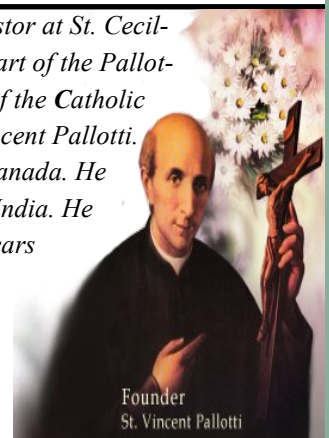
**St. Juan Diego** died in 1548 and was **buried in the first chapel dedicated to the Virgin of Guadalupe**. He was **beatified on 6 May 1990** by Pope John Paul II in the Basilica of Santa Maria di Guadalupe, Mexico City and was **Canonized on July 31, 2002, by Pope John Paul II**. **St. Juan Diego is the patron saint of Indigenous people**.

#### Saying of the Saint

“I am a **nobody**, I am a **small rope**, a **tiny ladder**, the **tail end**, a **leaf**.” - **St. Juan Diego**.

*Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallottine Fathers Community (Society of the Catholic Apostolate) who's patron is St. Vincent Pallotti. St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.*

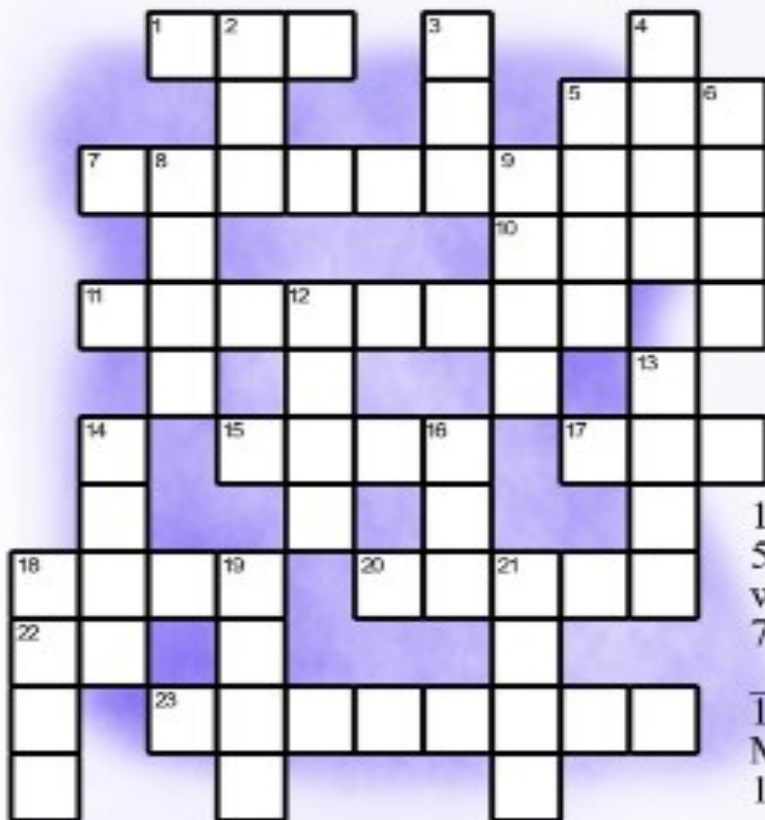

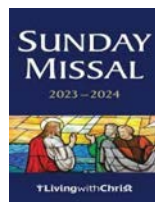

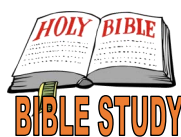
