



# FR. PAUL'S COLUMN SAINT OF THE WEEK

### ST. HILARY, BISHOP, AND DOCTOR OF THE CHURCH

13<sup>TH</sup> JAN



St. Hilary was born in Poitiers, a town in southwest France, in 315, into an upperclass, non-Christian family. He was raised as a pagan, given a solid liberal education, and was fluent in both Latin and Greek. He was married and had a daughter named Apra.

St. Hilary became aware of the Bible and began to read out of curiosity. St. Hilary was first struck by the mysterious name of God in the Old Testament: "I AM WHO I AM." He discovered the Son of God in the prologue of the John's Gospel. He had a deep appreciation for Jesus, the Gospels which led to his conversion and baptism in 350. Three years later St. Hilary was elected bishop of Poitiers.

St. Hilary was a firm defender of the Trinitarian doctrine of the Council of Nicaea (325) which declared that Jesus is divine, eternal, and consubstantial, of the same substance, as the Father.

St. Hilary is the Patron Saint of children academically behind, children learning to walk, mothers, and the sick.

### **Sayings of the Saint:**

"No matter how sinful one may have been, if he has devotion to Mary, it is ia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallotimpossible that he be lost". St. Hilary of Poitiers.

"The chief service I owe you, O God, is that every thought and word of mine should speak of you". St. Hilary of Poitiers.

He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.




