FR. PAUL'S COLUMN SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. FRANCES OF ROME, RELIGIOUS 1384 - 1440

MAR 9TH 2024



Saint Frances of Rome was born of a wealthy parent in Rome, Italy in 1384. She was drawn to a life of prayer, simplicity, bodily penance and fasting and was attracted to the religious life during her youth. But her parents objected and married her to Lorenzo de' Ponziani.

St. Frances embraced her marriage with her whole heart. She loved her husband, and he loved her. Her humble affection and devotion to him were so great that it has been said that during their forty years of married life, they never once had an argument. She loved and served God as a wife, mother, and religious. She learned to embrace God's will over her own.

St. Frances and other holy women in Rome were working hard to care for the poor and infirm. To help this work flourish, she organized a lay association of Benedictine Oblates for single and widowed women. She died on March 9, 1440, Rome and was canonized in 1608. Patron Saint of motorists and widows.






