




FR. PAUL'S COLUMN

40 HOURS DEVOTION FOR VOCATIONS in the Diocese of Calgary



We will be holding our 40 Hour Devotion starting at 6am on Friday, April 26th until 10pm Saturday, April 27th.

Very big congratulations to our RCIA Candidates who came into the Church at the Easter Vigil. Let us continue to welcome them, pray for them and journey with them. As we celebrate the Easter Octave as One Great Week, we invite you to attend our weekday Masses, Tuesday to Saturday at 9am

Next weekend, we will observe **<u>Divine Mercy Sunday</u>**. Following each Mass next weekend the Divine Mercy chaplet will be prayed, with the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, concluding with Benediction.

What is Divine Mercy Sunday?

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000. The Lord expressed His will with regard to this feast in His very first revelation to St. Faustina. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her *Diary* entry 699:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity... The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter.

Divine Mercy Sunday is NOT a feast based solely on St. Faustina's revelations. Indeed, it is not primarily about St. Faustina — nor is it altogether a new feast. The Second Sunday of Easter was already a solemnity as the Octave Day of Easter^[1]. The title "Divine Mercy Sunday" does, however, highlight the meaning of the day.






