

## FR. PAUL'S COLUMN

#### ST. MARTIN I, POPE, AND MARTYR

APRII 13<sup>TH</sup>

St. Martin I was born in Tuscany, Italy in 316. He is recognized as a saint and martyr in both the Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches.



St. Martin, I became a deacon and served in Rome, where he acquired a reputation for education, charity to the poor and holiness. As a cleric, he assisted two popes in important roles. Pope Theodore, I chose Martin as his representative to the emperor in Constantinople during a period of theological controversy between the imperial capital and the Roman Church.

Pope Theodore died in 649 and named St. Martin as his successor. He was the 74th Pope from 649 to 653. He called the Lateran Council of 649, a council that his predecessor Pope Theodore had intended to call and made Monothelitism the topic of discussion. The Lateran Council was attended by 105 bishops, held five sessions, and issued twenty decrees condemning Monothelitism.

St. Martin, I died in 655 from the effects of the torture and imprisonment. Pope Martin I is the last Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilmartyred Pope.


Over and over, we are invited to place our trust in God. We can imagine the terrified followers of Jesus hiding behind locked doors.

### Elizabeth House's Beach Carnival & Dodgeball Tournament -






