

APRIL 23RD

St. George was born around the year 280 to noble Christian parents in Cappadocia, modern-day Turkey.



St. George is honored in the Catholic Church as one of the most illustrious martyrs of Christ. By the end of the fourth century, St. George was revered throughout Palestine and the Eastern Byzantine Empire. By the fifth century, devotion to him spread to the Western Roman Empire.

St. George was well known for the famous episode of the dragon and the girl saved by the saint. According to the legend in the city of Selem in Libya, there was a large pond where a terrible dragon lived, and the inhabitants offered him two sheep a day and later a sheep and a child drawn by lot.
