
Every First Friday beginning with the 7pm Mass which is now run by the Youth Group. Meeting concludes by 9pm.

# FR. PAUL'S COLUMN SAINT OF THE WEEK

## ST. GREGORY II, THE POPE

FEB 13<sup>TH</sup>

St. Gregory II, the Pope was born around the year 669 and was a member of the wealthy Savelli family in Rome and his parents were Honesta and Marcellus. He was sent to help with the papal court at a young age. He worked under Pope Sergius I and became the treasurer of the court. He was later ordained as a sub deacon and then made a deacon. This led to him working in the Vatican Library.

St. Gregory II was elected to the papacy in 715 as the 89th pope in the Church and ruled for more than 15 years. His papacy goes hand in hand with the rule of Emperor Leo III. Leo passed a new rule that increased taxes, but that rule would eliminate the reserves that the Church had. St. Gregory fought back, which would lead to the emperor dropping the rule but continue his opposition to the papacy.

St. Gregory II sponsored the missionary activities of <u>St. Boniface</u> in Germany, and, like Gregory I, Gregory II converted his

family mansion into a monastery. He also performed a Miracle at the Battle of Toulouse in 721. St. Gregory died of natural causes in 731 after surviving an assassination attempt.

Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallottine Fathers Community (Society of the Catholic Apostolate) whose patron is St. Vincent Pallotti. St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.





Bernard Guillaumet, a non-Christian French journalist, is assigned the job of doing a story on Lourdes in the late 1990s. Just before he leaves for Lourdes, Bernard learns that his wife is pregnant. However, he is not told that this pregnancy could

put her life at risk--and that doctors are suggesting an abortion. While researching for his report on Lourdes, Bernard comes across the pages of an old family manuscript. The manuscript was written by his ancestor, Henri Guillaumet, a positivist scientist and nonbeliever who met Bernadette at Lourdes in 1858, a meeting which profoundly affected Henri and forced him to reconsider the miracles performed following the apparitions of the Madonna of Lourdes. One of the most important miracles H. Giullaumet had to reconsider was the healing of his wife Claire, who had been on her death bed as a result of tuberculosis, and was completely restored by the miraculous waters of the grotto in which Bernadette saw Our Lady. This intriguing film uses the pages of the manuscript to trace the stories of three lives—Bernadette, Henry, and Bernard—three characters whose lives intertwine as they pursue parallel journeys according to the designs of Providence.



**World Day of Prayer** 

In cooperation with our neighbouring churches, this year St. Cecilia's is hosting the World Day of Prayer on Saturday, March 8th. The theme this year is "I made you wonderful" inspired by Psalm 139:14. The origins of World Day of Prayer date back to the 19th century when Christian women of United States and Canada initiated a variety of cooperative activities in support of women's involvement in mission at home and in other parts of the world. In the second half of 1926 the women of North America distributed the worship service to as many countries and partners in mission as they could. From 1927 up to now, women gather to

pray with women from a different country. This year we pray with the women from Cook Islands. The prayer service will begin at 1pm following by refreshments in the hall.






