
Every First Friday beginning with the 7pm Mass which is now run by the Youth Group. Meeting concludes by 9pm.



FR. PAUL'S COLUMN SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. HILARY, the POPE

FEB 28



St. Hilary, the Pope, was born around 400 in Sardina, Italy. St. Hilary was used by Pope St. Leo the Great on many assignments. When Leo died, Hilary was elected pope and consecrated on November 19, 461 as 46th Pope. He was Pope from 461 - 468.

St. Hilary—who was a **firm defender of the divinity of Christ**—was a gentle and courteous man, devoted to writing some of the greatest theology on the Trinity. He **worked diligently to strengthen the Church** in <u>France</u> and Spain, calling councils in 462 and 465.

St. Hilary rebuilt many Roman churches and erected the <u>chapel</u> of <u>St. John Lateran</u>. He also built three chapels adjoining the Lateran Baptistry: one dedicated to St. John the Baptist, another to St. John the Evangelist, and a third to the Holy Cross. He was also the guardian of Church unity.

St. Hilary died around the age of 68, on February 29, 468, a leap year day.

Sayings of the Saint

"The chief service I owe you, O God, is that every thought and word of mine should speak of you". St. Hilary.

"No matter how sinful one may have been, if he has devotion to Mary, it is impossible that he be lost". St. Hilary.

Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallottine Fathers Community (Society of the Catholic Apostolate) whose patron is St. Vincent Pallotti. St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.

The origins of World Day of Prayer date back to the 19th century when Christian women of United States and Canada initiated a variety of cooperative activities in support of women's involvement in mission at home and in other parts of the world. In the second half of 1926 the women of North America distributed the worship service to as many countries and partners in mission as they could. From 1927 up to now, women gather to



pray with women from a different country. This year we pray with the women from Cook Islands. The prayer service will begin at 1pm following by refreshments in the hall.


