


# FR. PAUL'S COLUMN

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. JOSAPHAT, BISHOP AND MARTYR

1580 – 1623      NOV 12<sup>TH</sup> 24



**St. Josaphat** was born in the then Polish region of Lithuania of Orthodox parents and **given the name John at baptism**. In 1604, eight years after his local diocese reunited with Rome, John **entered religious life as a monk** at the Monastery of Holy Trinity of the Order of Saint Basil the Great in Vilnius. Upon entering, he was **given the religious name Josaphat**. After five years in the monastery, Brother Josaphat was **ordained a Catholic priest in the Eastern Rite** and remained at the monastery for the next eight years, becoming prior of his and several other monasteries.


- **St. Josaphat** lived as a monk in **a very mortified life**, went barefoot even in winter, refrained from the use of wine and flesh-meat, and **always wore a penitential garb**, diligently studied the history of the Church, the liturgy, and other documents **pertaining to the unity of the Church**.

**St. Josaphat** was a spiritual leader, a man of prayer, and **a man on a mission of unification**. He not only **convinced many of the Orthodox holdouts to embrace the Catholic faith**, but he also even drew some who had become Calvinists after the Protestant Reformation. He was so successful that he **earned the nickname “Soul-snatcher.”**

**St. Josaphat** ministry was so impactful that, in 1617, he was **ordained as the Bishop of Vitebsk** and, one year later, was **elevated to the Archbishop of Polotsk**. As a bishop, he **worked faithfully for the unity of the Church until he suffered martyrdom** at the hands of an angry mob in Russia in 1623 at the age of forty-three. He was the **first saint of the Eastern Church to be canonized by Rome**. He was Canonized by Pope Pius IX on June 29, 1867. He is the **Patron Saint of Ukraine** and one of the **patrons of Poland**.

*Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallottine Fathers Community (Society of the Catholic Apostolate) whose patron is St. Vincent Pallotti. St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.*




