
Every First Friday beginning with the 7pm Mass. Meeting concludes by 9pm.



FR. PAUL'S COLUMN SAINT OF THE WHEK

ST. SYLVESTER I, POPE

DEC 31ST 24



St. Vincent Pallotti

St. Sylvester I, was born in Rome around the year 250. At a young age, his mother put him under the care of a priest to be taught the practice of religion and sacred literature. He was ordained a priest by St Pope Marcellinus.

St. Sylvester I, enjoyed providing shelter to Christians passing through the city. He would take them with him, wash their feet, serve them at table and care for them, all in the name of Jesus Christ. One of the Christians whom St. Sylvester hosted was St Timothy of Antioch, an illustrious confessor of the faith.

St. Sylvester I, was the Pope from 314 to 335, whose long pontificate saw the beginnings of the Christian Roman Empire. The most important event of his reign was the Council of Nicaea in May 325. During his pontificate were built the great churches founded in Rome by Constantine, including St Peter's Basilica, the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem and the Basilica of St John Lateran. He is connected also with the establishment of the Roman school of singing.

St. Sylvester I, died on 31 December 335, in Rome, Italy. He is believed to have built a church, where he was buried, at the cemetery of St.

Priscilla on the Via Salaria. His relics were transferred in 762 by the pope St. Paul I to the basilica of San Silvestro in Capite.

St. Sylvester I, is the patron saint of animals, good harvests, stone masons, Order of Saint Sylvester, and Italy.

Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallottine Fathers Community (Society of the Catholic Apostolate) whose patron is St. Vincent Pallotti. St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.


