

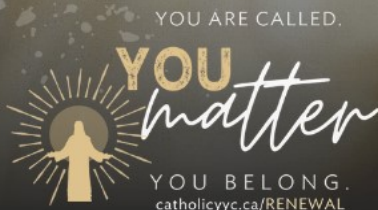

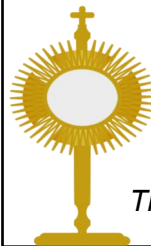

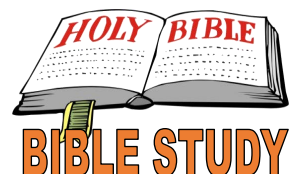
Prayer Shawl Ministry: last Tuesday of the month after the 9am Mass. New knitters welcome. Yarn is available.

Acts of the Apostles | Every Tuesday after the 9am Mass in the boardroom.

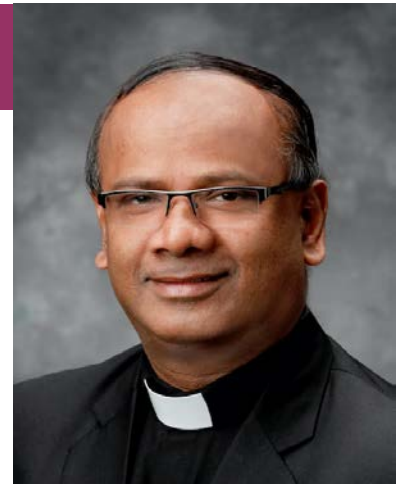

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. JOHN OF DAMASCUS

MARCH 27TH



St. John Damascus was born in Damascus to Christian parents. All the **information we have on St. John of Damascus are through the records of John, Patriarch of Jerusalem.** He received a classical and theological education and followed his father in a government position under the Arabs. He **became increasingly sensitive to the non-Christian environment and feared its influence.** In his mid- to late-twenties, he **resigned his position,** sold his possessions, and **retreated to the desert monastery of Mar Saba, near Jerusalem,**

● **St. John Damascus** spent his first twenty years **growing in spiritual perfection** in the monastery as a monk. He **embraced monastic disciplines,** studied, prayed, did penance, and entrusted himself to His merciful God. As he **advanced so greatly in the spiritual life, humility, and learning,** that his superiors thought that **he is worthy of priestly ordination,** which was **uncommon among the monks.** They also believed that he could offer great service to the Church as a priest through ministry and writing. **St. John Damascus was ordained** and instructed by his superiors to address important theological issues within the Caliphate and Byzantine Empire.

St. John Damascus is the **Patron Saint of pharmacists, icon painters, and theology students.** He was **Declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Leo XIII in 1890.**

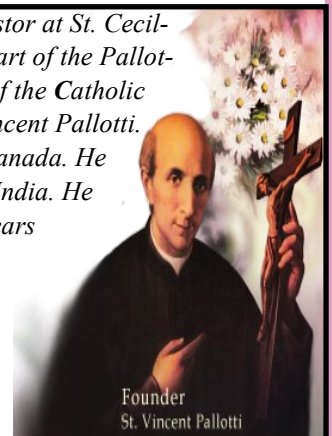
Sayings of the Saint

St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.

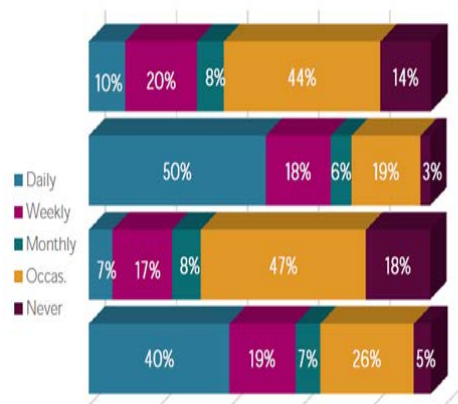

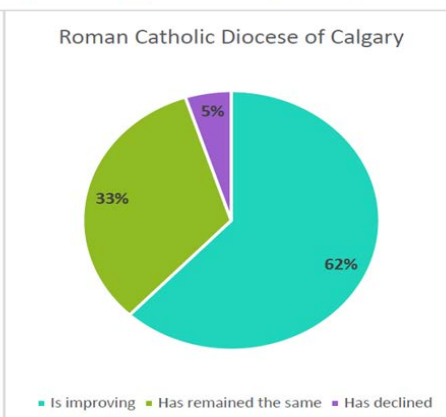

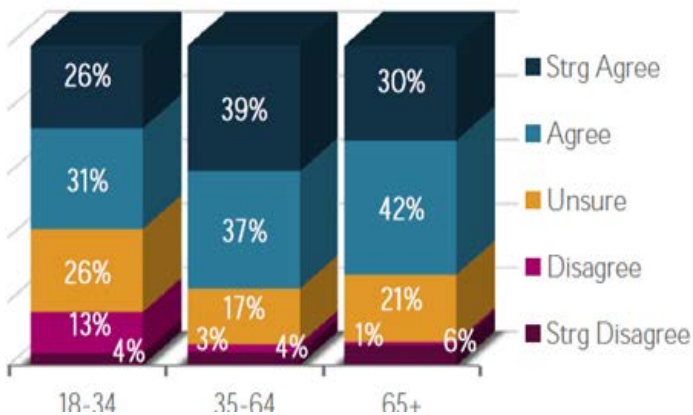

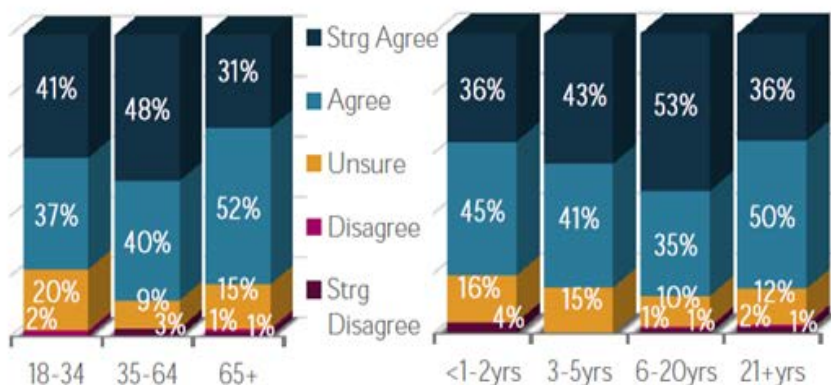

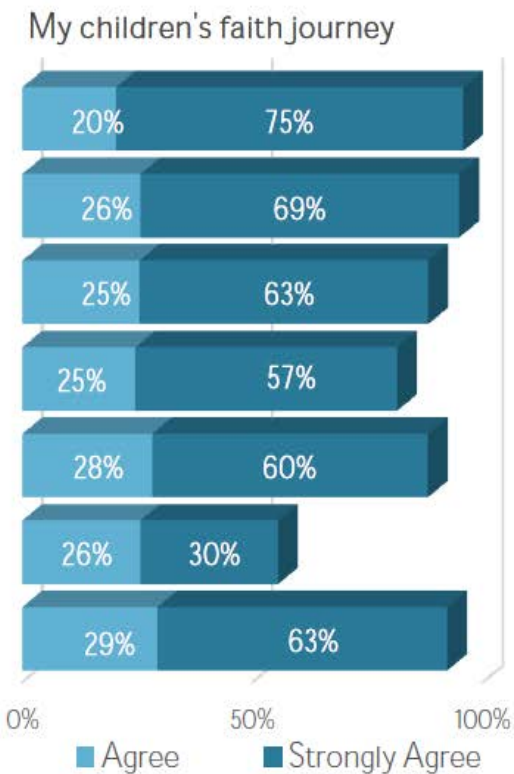

Bishops raise serious concerns about threats to charitable status designation

On Monday, 10 March 2025, the members of the Permanent Council of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) expressed their grave concern regarding two recommendations made by the House of Commons Standing Committee on Finance within [Report 21: Pre-Budget Consultations in Advance of the 2025 Budget](#). These recommendations (#429 and #430), if adopted, would be profoundly detrimental to Canada's charitable sector, because they would:

- Revoke the charitable status of “anti-abortion organizations” (#429);
- Amend the *Income Tax Act* such that “the advancement of religion” would no longer qualify as a legitimate purpose for granting charitable status. (#430)

After consulting widely, including with experts in charity law, the members of the Permanent Council sent a letter to the Hon. Dominic LeBlanc, Minister of Finance, defending the value and role of faith-based charities for Canadian society, as well as the unfairness of targeting pro-life organizations. They urged the government to abandon the two recommendations and to conduct comprehensive consultations within the charitable sector before embarking on any legislative changes that could threaten the viability of charitable organizations and adversely affect the millions of Canadians who depend on them for essential services and support.

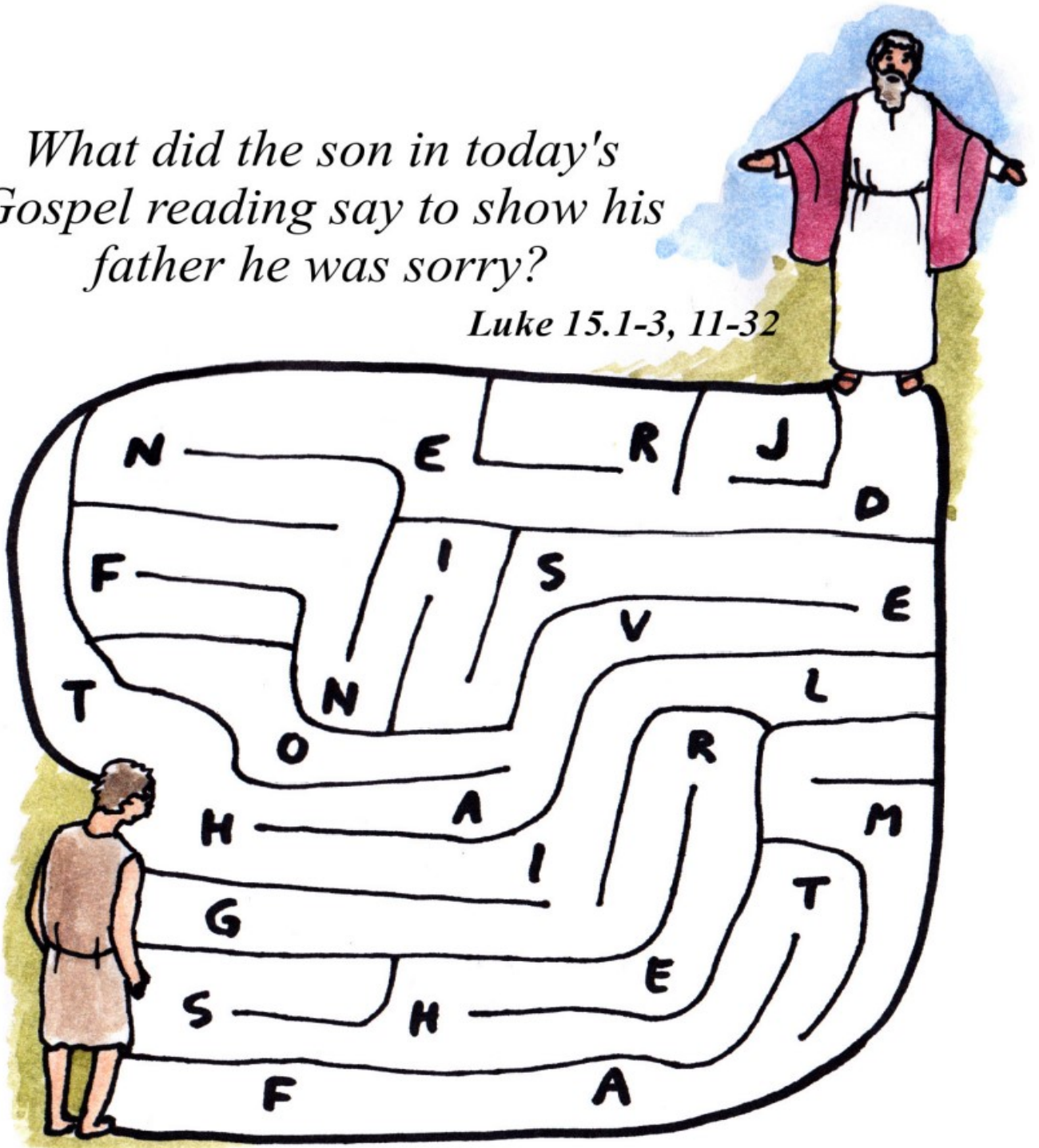
