

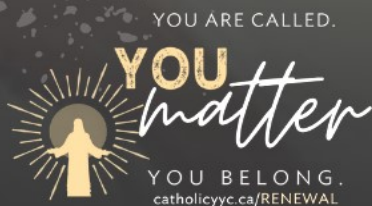

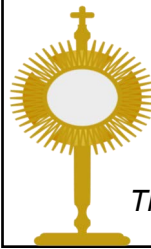

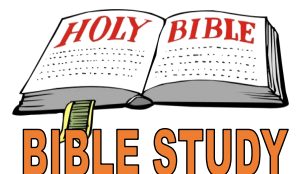
Prayer Shawl Ministry: last Tuesday of the month after the 9am Mass. New knitters welcome. Yarn is available.

Acts of the Apostles | Every Tuesday after the 9am Mass in the boardroom.

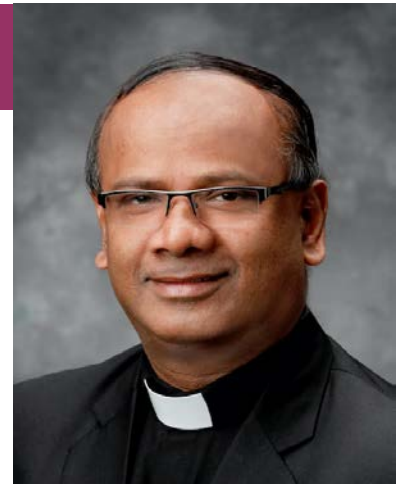


FR. PAUL'S COLUMN

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST. VINCENT FERRER

APRIL 5TH



St. Vincent Ferrer was born in 1350 in Valencia, Spain. He was one of the greatest saints of the Dominican Order.

St. Vincent Ferrer had a powerful voice of remarkable range, clear and resonant as a silver trumpet, which is one of his symbols. St. Vincent had the gift of tongues. Speaking in his own language, all who listened to him could understand him in theirs. He was known for extraordinary miracles: He raised forty people from the dead, He cured thousands of the blind, the lame, the deaf and the dumb and he extinguished a fire with one blow of his breath.

St. Vincent Ferrer tirelessly preached, fasted, and tended to the sick, leaving a legacy of zeal and devotion. For twenty-one years he spent his life preaching in England, Scotland, Ireland, Spain, France, Switzerland, and Italy, his mission influenced thousands, converting many, including Jews and Muslims. Kings, queens, bishops, civic magistrates invited him to their cities and sought his counsel.

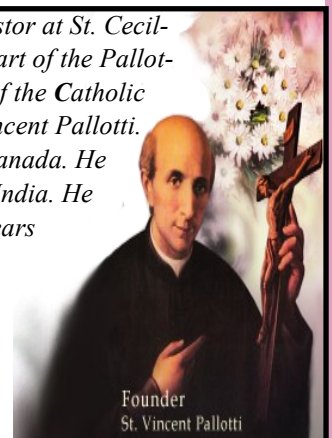
St. Vincent Ferrer died at the age of 69 on April 5, 1419, during his preaching mission in France. He was buried in the cathedral in Vannes, France. He is the patron saint of Builders. St. Vincent Ferrer is the patron saint of builders because of his fame for "building up" and strengthening the Church: through his preaching, missionary work, in his teachings, as confessor and adviser.

Saying of the Saint

“Once humility is acquired, charity will come to life; a burning flame devouring the corruption of vice and filling the heart so full that there is no place for vanity”. - St. Vincent Ferrer.

Fr. Paul Raj, SAC has been the pastor at St. Cecilia's since November 2014 and is part of the Pallottine Fathers Community (Society of the Catholic Apostolate) whose patron is St. Vincent Pallotti. St. Cecilia's is his first parish in Canada. He comes from the Tamil province of India. He was also in the Philippines for 3 years serving and studying.

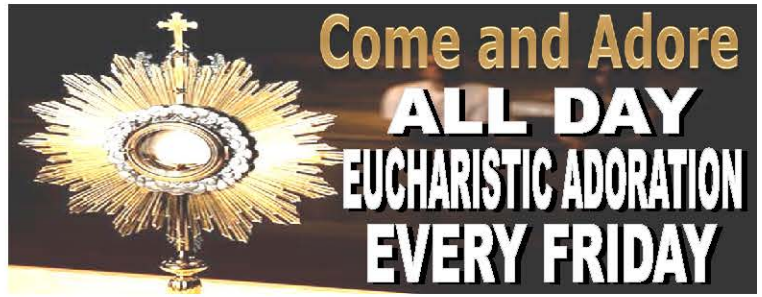

FUND FORWARD notice from CWL:



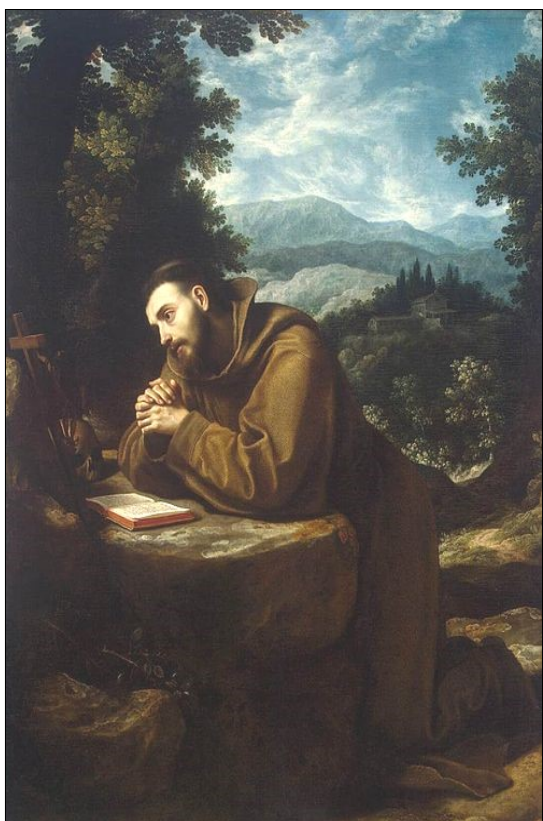

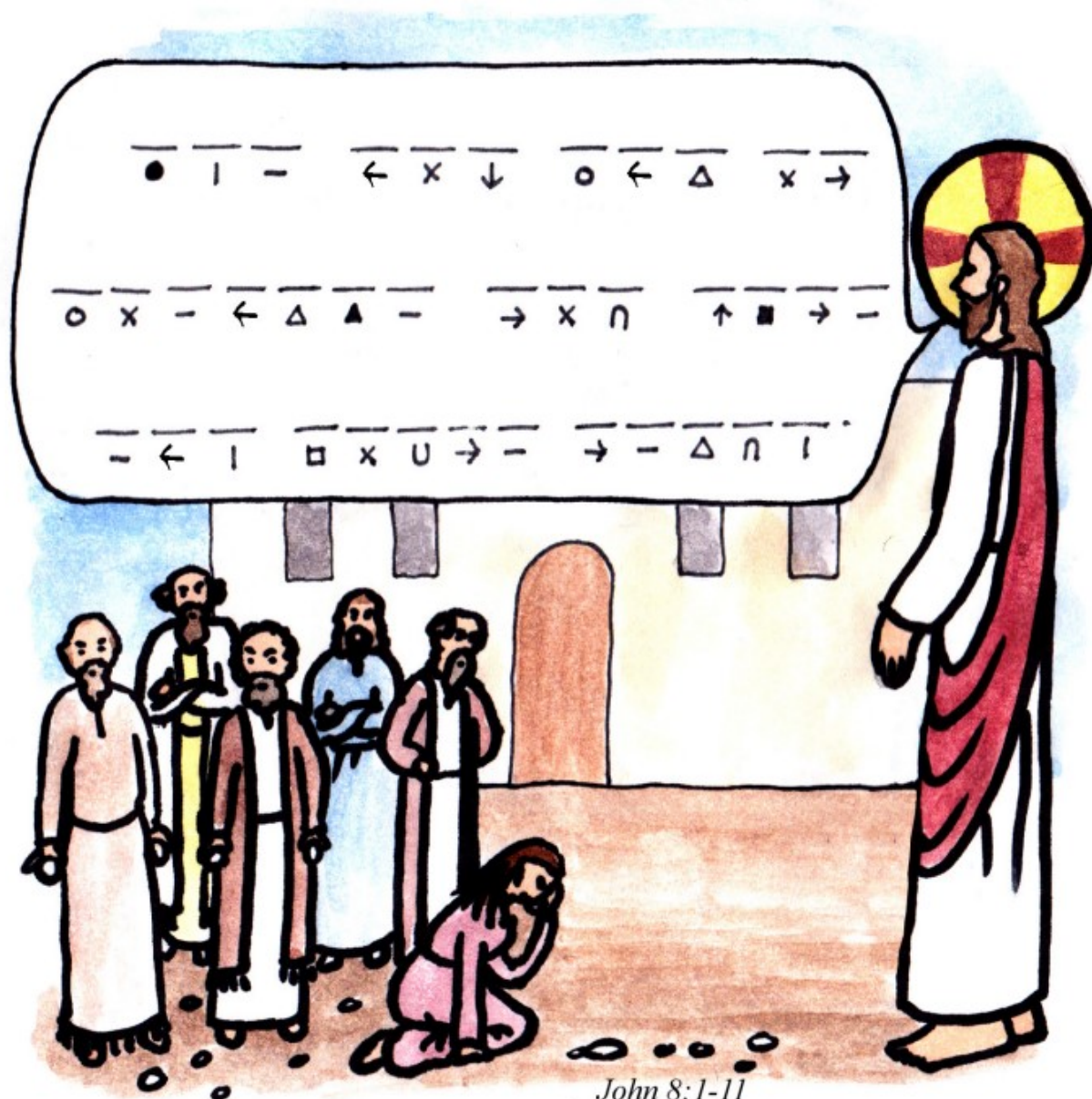


