

Pastor's Message

This Friday, September 26, is the Feast of the Canadian Martyrs, the Secondary Patrons of Canada. In the 17th century, Jesuit missionaries travelled from France to modern-day Canada and New England to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the First Nations peoples. Eight of them, six priests and two laymen, were killed for the faith between 1642 and 1649: St. Isaac Jogues, St. Antoine Daniel, St. Jean de Brébeuf, St. Gabriel Lalemant, St. Charles Garnier, St. Noël Chabanel, St. René Goupil, and St. Jean de la Lande. The story of their selfless labours, brutal torments, and heroic martyrdom is far less known today than it should be. These men brought the Catholic faith to our country and watered its soil with their blood. Before Today, Canada needs to be evangelized once again. Let us ask the holy Canadian Martyrs to pray for us, that inspired by their courageous example, we might seek to win our fellow countrymen for Christ.

"God is the witness of our sufferings, and will soon be our exceeding great reward. Let us die in this faith...Sustain with courage the few remaining torments. They will end our lives. The glory which follows them will never have an end." —St. Jean de Brébeuf
