2026 Together in Action

In the spirit of the Jubilee Year proclaimed by Pope Francis, our Diocese launched the Multiply the Hope campaign to support parish renewal through matching funds available until the end of 2027. To qualify, parishes must first meet their operating budget and TIA goals. Across the Diocese, the campaign has already matched \$4 million for parish loans and \$3 million for repairs and maintenance, helping essential projects move forward and strengthening parish communities in faith and service. An additional \$4.9 million in matching funds remains available. Our parish goal is \$158,425, and in 2025 we were able to contribute \$52,290 from our operational surplus. PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Let the whole world tremble; let heaven exult when Christ, the Son of the Living God, is on the altar in the hands of the priest." —St. Francis of Assisi

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, commonly known as Corpus Christi. ("Corpus Christi" is Latin for "Body of Christ.") This feast was established by Pope Urban IV in 1264. The previous year, a Eucharistic miracle had occurred near the city of Orvieto Italy: while celebrating Mass, a Bohemian priest who was having doubts about Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist saw the Host begin to bleed. In the Holy Eucharist, Christ is really, truly, and substantially present - just as present as when He walked the earth two thousand years ago.

It is a longstanding tradition on the feast of Corpus Christi to hold outdoor Eucharistic processions in order to express *publicly* our faith in Christ's Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Please join us for our Corpus Christi procession in the parking lot after the 11 am Mass!

The month of June is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is this Friday, June 12. This day is also World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. Please see the details inside the bulletin regarding our all-day Eucharistic Adoration until midnight.

The same day, June 12, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the church for Adoration from 9 am till midnight. One of the elements of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is reparation for sin, and we will therefore offer our Adoration in reparation for all sins committed against the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In a special way, we will pray in reparation for euthanasia, abortion, and other sins committed against human life. June 2026 marks the tenth anniversary since the legalization of euthanasia and assisted suicide in Canada, so it is particularly fitting that we pray for an end to euthanasia and assisted suicide in our country. We will also pray for the sanctification of priests.
